- Partnership Planning: Provide support for organisations' planning and execution of collaborations with other art and creative groups as well as partners in other sectors

- Partnership Coordination: Coordinate and facilitate artistic experimentations and placemaking initiatives by connecting and liaising with creative partners; providing delivery support for art and creative happenings

Associate Artist in Early Childhood Education

Purpose

- Assist in planning and preparing the learning environment, setting up interest corners, and preparing needed materials and supplies (gives primary consideration to the safety and health of the children when planning the environment)
- Assist preschool teachers in the general supervision and management of the children
- Assist in the ongoing evaluation procedures needed to assess the developmental levels of the children
- Attend all staff meetings, training and parent activities
- Assist in public events organized by the Nursery School/Kindergarten/the Organisation
- Participate in professional organisations that work for the improvement of early childhood education
- Support the philosophy of the Nursery School/Kindergarten/the Organisation
